### Maths

Throughout Early Years we are having a big push on number work. Can you help us at home with this? Please find opportunities to count with your child eg counting apples into the fruit bowl, counting socks out of the washing, counting plates at the dinner table. Can your child count to 10? Encourage your child to point to objects as they count and then say 'How many are there?'
