Term: Spring 2 **Topic:** Let's be curious about how things change.

Literacy

To develop writing skills across all curricular areas writing for a range of purposes. We will be writing free verse poetry and conversations based on a topic that is important to us. To perform work to an audience using tone, pitch and pace.

Maths

To use formal methods to multiply and divide numbers with up to 4 digits by 1 and 2-digit numbers. To compare fractions and recognise equivalent fractions. To change fractions into mixed numbers and vice-versa.

Topic (art, DT, history, geography)

We will be learning about how the British legal system has changed and evolved over time. We will look at typical crime and punishment during different periods of British history from the Vikings up to present day. We will learn about Tudor crime and punishment and use the Globe Theatre as inspiration for our art work. We will practise a range of drawing techniques and use mod-roc to create models.

Science

Can we transform materials and what is actually in the jar? We will learn about reversible and irreversible changes and how we can use this to separate some mixtures and solutions.

Computing

We will be using Sketch-Up to draw and design 3D models and buildings. We will learn new skills that allow us to see our work from all angles and even design the inside of our building.
