House Party is a face-to-face video messaging app that children **aged 13+** can use to talk to one another whilst they are at home.

Anyone can join this app, so it's very important to stay safe, have a look below at what you can do:

1. Only chat with people you know in real life and use private mode.
2. Make sure to 'lock the room' to prevent uninvited guests from joining.
3. Try using Houseparty with your parents or other adults in your home to get an idea of how it works.
4. Encourage kindness and respect online – to help create a safer internet for everyone.
5. Never share photos of yourself online, even if your friends ask.
6. Block or report users who are unkind or make you feel unsafe.

Privacy

Set your account to private using these simple instructions:

- On the top left corner tap on the 
- Tap on 
- Scroll to **Private Mode** and swipe the tab right.
- Select **Enable Private Mode**.


Block

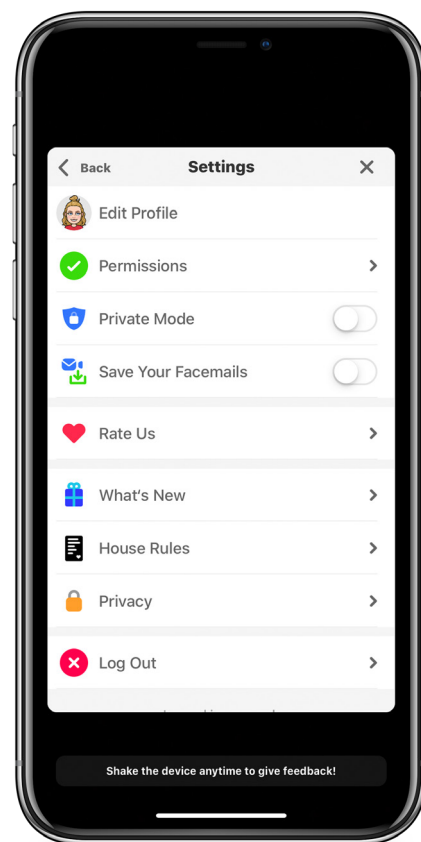
Block a user using these simple instructions:

- Tap on the user's name and then tap on 
- Tap on **Block**.
- Tap on **Block** again.

Report

Report a user using these simple instructions:

- Tap on the user's name and then tap on 
- Tap on **Yes**.
- Tap on **Start**.
- Answer the different questions and submit.
