Topic: Where in the World is Beeston?

Literacy

We will focus on the book Beegu and make our own Beegu's, using adjectives to describe her. We will tell her all about Beeston and why she should visit, before writing our own Beegu stories.

We will be sharing lots of stories, practising our reading, and ensuring we write in full sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Maths

We will be working on our place value skills; identifying how many tens and ones a number has and using part whole models to show our knowledge eg 37 is 3 tens and 7 ones.

$$30 + 7 = 37$$

We will practise recognising, reading and writing numbers to 100.

Topic (Art, DT, History, Geography, Computing)

We will be learning about:

- Where Beeston is, local landmarks and how Beeston has changed within living memory and beyond.
- Comparing the work of varying artists, including local artist Jo Dunn and drawing Beeston in a similar style.
- Online safety. Purple Mash—coding.

Science

Animals including humans.

- Naming/describing animal groups eg mammals, reptiles, fish, etc.
- Looking after ourselves and staying healthy.
- Animal life cycles.

PSHE

To understand a healthy diet

To understand the importance of physical activity, sleep and rest

To recognise people who help us to stay healthy and well

To understand basic health and hygiene routines

PE is on a Wednesday. Our topic is Jumping

Phonics

Floppy Phonics— we will be recapping all the sounds we learnt in Year 1. Practising our tricky words.
