Happy New Year to you all. I hope you have all had a lovely break and managed to spend time with family and friends. It has been lovely to welcome all the children back to school and the term has got off to a good start.

Bagel Bar

This will also allow as many children as possible to have breakfast before learning starts.

Covid-19 update

I'm sure many of you are aware of the ever-changing guidance around symptoms, testing and isolation but I have provided an overview for your information.

The three main symptoms of covid-19 remain the same: a high temperature of 37.8 degrees or above, a new and persistent cough and/or a loss of smell and taste. In addition to this the British Medical Journal has published a list of typical symptoms associated with the Omicron variant. These are: a runny nose, sore throat, sneezing, headache and fatigue. Whilst any or all of the above could well just be a common cold, it would be wise to play on the safe side, test more regularly using Lateral Flow Tests (<https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>).

From 11th January under the new guidance released yesterday, anyone in England who receives a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result should report their result on gov.uk and must self-isolate immediately but will not need to take a follow-up PCR test. **This is a temporary measure while COVID-19 rates remain high across the UK. Whilst levels of COVID-19 are high, the vast majority of people with positive LFD results can be confident that they have COVID-19.** After reporting a positive LFD test result, they will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace so that their contacts can be traced.

Rules on Self-isolation:

Self-isolation advice for people with coronavirus has changed. It is now possible to end self-isolation after 7 days. Individuals may now take LF tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results on these days are no longer

required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and children may return to school.

Anyone who is unable to take the LFD tests will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.

Children who have come into contact with someone with coronavirus, whilst not needing to isolate, to attend school should take a daily LFT for 7 days and self-isolate if positive. For full details please refer to the following website:
