Topic: Freestyle

Literacy

We will be writing traditional tales from a different point-of-view, with a focus on complex sentences and different ways to describe. We will also be writing a letter of complaint based on children's interests.

Maths

We will learn to recognise and write fractions using numbers, pictures and representations. We will focus on fractions being a part of a whole and use the terms numerator and denominator.

History

Our topic is The Mayan Civilization. We will be trying to answer the question of how significant is Mayan civilization nowadays. Using artefacts and photos, we will try to discover how Mayans lived their day to day lives and what was important to them. We will try to imagine how a Mayan city might have looked using recent photographs and try some Mayan foods which we still have today. Finally, we will try and find where evidence of Mayan civilizations can be found.

Science

Our science topic 'Light'. We will try to answer the question how do light and shadows impact our daily lives. We will try to understand what sources of light there are. We will also think about the uses and dangers of too much and not enough light.
