Topic: Can you travel in time?

Literacy

We will be reading the stories "Traction Man" and "Lost in the Toy Museum". We will then write our own stories focusing on finger spaces, capital letters, full stops, using adjectives and joining sentences together using 'and'.

Home Learning: You can help by reading lots of stories at bedtime and encourage children to guess what will happen next.

Maths

Count, write, order and make numbers to 20 and know which is one more and one less

Home Learning: You can help by doing lots of counting- counting toys, objects, looking for numbers when shopping. See if your child can write all the numbers to twenty the correct way round.

Topic (Art, DT, Geography, History, PE, RE, Computing)

History: Learn all about Toys from the past.

DT: Making a moving picture.

PE: Dance on TUESDAYS. This will be indoors.

Computing: Making story books

Home Learning: You can help by showing your child toys you played with when you were a child.

Home Learning: You can help at home by identifying different signs of Winter when outside.

Phonics

We are now in different groups for phonics depending on need. We continue to learn a new sound everyday and will continue to practice "alien words" which will prepare us for the Phonics Screen Check.

Home Learning: You can help by listening to your child read their book a few times during the week.

Reminders
