

Community and Global Links

At Greenmount Primary, our aim is to develop children who are global learners, who feel connected with the wider world. We want them to be passionate about their local community and wider world and for children to be aware of themselves as global citizens.

Children leave Greenmount with a self-awareness of themselves and their role in their local community and the wider world. They understand how by working together we can all have a positive impact on our world.

In order to achieve our aims, we:

- Have established a global partnership with Matiri Primary School in Kenya, this was done through a Connecting Classrooms project with the British Council.
- Take part in collaborative projects with our link school in Kenya and the Nursing home, often involving whole school art projects and class discussions via Zoom.
- Encourage children to experience debating and communicating with others from different communities, ages and cultures.
- Have established local links with Pennington Court Nursing home, the local Church and the Mosque.
- We work with the Linking Schools Network which brings together two classes from demographically different areas. We are currently linked with a school in Devon and another in Otley, Leeds.
- We celebrate and learn about different cultures, such as naming our classes after British mountaineers that are reflective of modern Britain.
- We work together towards the Sustainable Development Goals, by collaborative projects and assemblies.
