Literacy

This half term we are reading Traction Man and writing our own stories about an action figure.

We will also read the Lost Toy Museum and write recounts about a lost toy.

Home Learning: Practice your spellings and letter formation at home; remembering tall letters, tail letters and small letters.

Maths

Recognising, counting, and making numbers to 20. Understanding teen numbers. Addition and subtraction with numbers up to 20.

Home Learning: Using Numbots to support mathematical understanding. Weekly maths homework.

History: Learning about how toys have changed within living memory.

DT: Designing and making hedgehog houses.
