Literacy

This half term we are reading Little Red Riding Hood and using adjectives to describe.

We will also look at non-fiction books and write non-chronological reports about Wolves.

Home Learning: Practice your spellings and letter formation at home; remembering tall letters, tail letters and small letters.

Maths

Recognising, counting, and making numbers to 50. Measuring length and height, volume (capacity) and mass (weight).

Home Learning: Using Numbots to support mathematical understanding. Weekly maths homework.

Topic (Art, DT, Geography, History, PE, RE, Computing)

Geography: Learning all about the 4 Countries that make up the UK.

Art: Landscapes and Cityscapes

RE: What does it mean to belong to a Church or Mosque?

Computing: Spreadsheets and online safety.

PE: Dance – 1 Cool. Gymnastics – 1 Hinkes

Science

Plants – understanding the parts of a plant and how they grow. Identifying and naming types of trees and flowers. Knowing what deciduous and evergreen trees are.

Home Learning: What trees and flowers do you see at home and on your way to school?

Phonics

We are now in different groups for phonics depending on our need. We continue to learn a new sound every day and learning “alien words” to prepare us for the Phonics Screen Check in June.

Homework: In Year 1 your child will bring their book bags home every night and bring them back to school every morning. Please encourage your child to read their book a few times during the week. This will help them become fluent in reading.
