World

The earth and all the people, places and things on it.

Equator

an imaginary line drawn around the middle of the earth an equal distance from the North Pole and the South Pole.

North/South Pole

The furthest Northern/Southern point on the earth's surface.

Continent

One of the seven large land masses on the earth's surface, surrounded, or mainly surrounded, by sea and usually consisting of various countries.

Region

An area or part of the world.
