Literacy

This half term we are reading The Journey Home and finding out about endangered animals.

We will be using the 'First Animal Encyclopaedia' to learn and write about animals.

Home Learning: Practice your spellings and letter formation at home; remembering tall letters, tail letters and small letters.

Maths

Multiplication and Division: Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Sharing into equal groups.

Home Learning: Using Numbots to support mathematical understanding. Weekly maths homework. Practice counting forwards and backwards to 50.

Topic (Art, DT, Geography, History, PE, RE, Computing)

Geography: Comparing the UK to hot and cold places around the world.

DT: Making smoothies

RE: How and why do we care for others?

Computing: Coding

PE: Games: Rackets, bats and balls.

Science

Plants – understanding the parts of a plant and how they grow. Identifying and naming types of trees and flowers. Knowing what deciduous and evergreen trees are.

Home Learning: What trees and flowers do you see at home and on your way to school?

Phonics

We are now in different groups for phonics depending on our need. We continue to learn or recap a new sound every day and learning "alien words" to prepare us for the Phonics Screen Check in June.

Reminders
