Literacy

We will be making our own non-fiction texts about what happens at night time.

We will read Emily Brown and the Thing and write our own stories.

Home Learning: You can help by continuing to share lots of stories at home and read your child's book with them to aid understanding.

Maths

Addition and subtraction within 10.
Recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes.
Counting and describing how many corners and sides.

Home Learning: You can help by doing lots of counting- forwards and backwards. Identifying simple shapes in your home. Cylinder tins, cube and cuboid boxes, circle plates etc.

Topic (Art, DT, Geography, History, PE, RE, Computing)

History: Learning about Neil Armstrong and Mae Jemison and their journey to space.

Art: Printing: How are shapes used in art?

PE – Ball Skills. (Thursdays – children come to school in their PE kit)

RE – Why are festivals important in a community? (Pathway 5)

Computing – Online safety, Grouping and sorting, Pictograms.

Phonics

We are now in different groups for phonics depending on our need. We continue to learn a new sound everyday and will start to learn “alien words” which will prepare us for the Phonics Screen Check.

Reminders

Homework: In Year 1 your child will bring their book bags home every night and bring them back to school every morning. Please encourage your child to read their book a few times during the week. This will help them become fluent in reading.
