### Leave abroad requests

National Penalty Notice Framework (three year rolling period)

<b>First Offence</b>	The first penalty notice will be issued at £160 per parent per child reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days.
<b>Second Offence</b>	Second penalty will be issued at £160 per parent per child this will not be reduced.
<b>Third Offence</b>	A penalty notice will not be issued, and the case will be considered for potential legal action. This can result in a criminal record and fines of up to £1000 plus costs.

### Is my child too ill for school?

The NHS has a useful link to help you decide if your child is too unwell to be in school.

<b>High Temperature</b>	Keep them off school until temperature has gone.
<b>Coughs and cold</b>	It is fine to send children to school with a cough or common cold.
<b>Chickenpox</b>	Keep them off school until all spots have crusted over.
<b>Cold Sores</b>	There is no need to keep children off school if they have cold sores.
<b>Conjunctivitis</b>	You don't need to keep children off school with conjunctivitis.
<b>COVID-19</b>	If your child has mild symptoms they can go to school.
<b>Ear Infection</b>	Accompanied with a high temperature keep off school until recovered
<b>Hand, Foot and Mouth</b>	Children are OK to attend school if they feel well enough.
<b>Head lice and nits</b>	There is no need to keep children off school with Head lice.
<b>Impetigo</b>	Keep of school until 48hrs after antibiotics have started or until scabs have crusted.
<b>Measles</b>	Keep child off school 4 days from rash appearing.
<b>Ringworm</b>	Children can attend school once treatment has started.
<b>Scarlet Fever</b>	Child can attend 24hrs after starting antibiotics.
<b>Slapped Cheek virus</b>	Children can attend school as no longer contagious when rash appears.
<b>Sore Throat</b>	Children can attend school with a sore throat if they don't have a temperature.
<b>Threadworms</b>	Children can attend school speak to pharmacy for treatment.
