Literacy

This half term we are reading Little Red Riding Hood and using adjectives to describe.

We will also look at non-fiction books and write non-chronological reports about Wolves.

Home Learning: Practice your spellings and letter formation at home; remembering tall letters, tail letters and small letters.

Maths

Addition and subtraction. Recognising, counting, and making numbers to 50. Measuring length and height, volume (capacity) and mass (weight).

Home Learning: Using Numbots to support mathematical understanding. Weekly maths homework.

Topic (Art, DT, Geography, History, PE, RE, Computing)

Geography: Learning all about the 4 Countries that make up the UK.

Art: Portraits and landscapes

RE: Which books and stories are important. (Pathway 6)

Computing: Spreadsheets, typing skills and online safety.

PE: Gymnastics

Science

Plants – understanding the parts of a plant and how they grow. Identifying and naming types of trees and flowers. Knowing what deciduous and evergreen trees are.

Home Learning: What trees and flowers do you see at home and on your way to school?
