Term: Autumn 1

Topic: Where in the world is Beeston?

Phonics

In group time we will be listening to environmental sounds, instrumental sounds and using our bodies to make sounds.

Home Learning: You can help by reading lots of stories at bedtime and encourage children to guess what will happen next.

Maths

In group time we will recite some number names in sequence, order numbers past five and select shapes appropriately e.g., flat surfaces for buildings or a triangular prism for a roof.'

Home Learning: You can help by counting lots of objects eg, during mealtimes count the spoons.

Our Topic—'I wonder what I was special about where I live'

We will be learning about where we live, who lives in my house and what we can see in Beeston. We will be working on talking in sentences by answering questions such as 'Who lives in your house?' 'Who is in your family' and identifying all families are different.

Home Learning: You can help by talking about where they live and who lives at home.

Stories

We will be reading the traditional story Goldilocks and the 3 bears and Little Rabbit Foo Foo. Our areas will recreate this story whilst developing fine and gross motor skills.

Clothes

Please ensure your child has a named bag with spare clothes in it in case they need to be changed. When it is bad weather, please could children wear wellies and a waterproof coat. Ensure all clothes have child's name in.
