Literacy

We will be retelling the story of Cinderella and The Great Henna Party and learning to describe the feast and the ball.

We will be writing non-fiction sentences on night-time.

We will be writing longer sentences dictated by our teachers and making sure we use our phonics, full stops, capital letters and finger spaces with growing independence.

Maths

Addition and subtraction within 10.

Recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes. Counting and describing how many corners and sides.

Home Learning: You can help by doing lots of counting- forwards and backwards. Identifying simple shapes in your home. Cylinder tins, cube and cuboid boxes, circle plates etc.
