Topic: I wonder how things grow and change

Phonics

In group time we will be listening and spotting rhyming words then we will start to spot alliteration words.

Getting ready for Reception

If your child is due to start Reception in September 2026 they will have daily name practice in Nursery. Every day your child will trace the letters of their name until they are ready to write it independently. You can help at home by practising their name at home.

Our Topic

We will learn about how plants and animals grow. We will be planting our own bean seeds and different herbs and watching them grow. We will meet lots of animals when the visitors "Lion Learners" come to school including a tarantula!
