**Term:** Spring 2  
**Topic:** Lets be curious

### Literacy

Spellings will continue to be sent home on Monday. We will be continuing to develop our creative story writing skills basing our ideas on the book *The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse*. We will look at how stories can be told from different view points and continuing to develop our year 5 grammar.

### Maths

We will be mastering short division where we will divide 4 digit numbers by 1 digit and start to interpret the remainder. We will continue our work on fractions where we will find fractions of an amount and learn how to multiply fractions. We will learn about equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

### DT, History, PSHE

Our topic is 'Lets be Curious.' In history, we will be asking 'What impact did the Tudors have on life in England today?' In DT we will be looking at structures and building and finding out about Isambard Brunel. In PSHE, we will discuss how to take care of themselves and manage changing emotions during puberty.

### Science

In Science, we will be answering the question 'How will I change over time?' this will include learning how humans change from birth to old age and includes changes during puberty.
