Key knowledge - five facts


I know that New York is a state within the USA.

I can identify and name key human features of New York and Yorkshire/Leeds such as Statue of Liberty, Times Square, Leeds to Liverpool canal, Millenium Square



I can locate Yorkshire and New York on a map using four and six figure grid references

State
