Term: Spring 2 **Topic:** *Let's be curious*

English

We are reading *Cloud Busting*, a narrative told through poetry. We will use this to write narratives that use dialogue to advance the action and write parallel diary entries. In non-fiction, we will write non-chronological reports.

Maths

We learning about percentages and how to find a percentage of an amount and the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be applying our multiplication and division skills to area, perimeter and volume.

Topic (Geography and RE)

In Geography, we will be answering the question. 'How do New York and Yorkshire compare?' We will be learning about time zones and comparing human and physical features. In RE we will be learning how growing up brings responsibilities and commitments. We will look at different rites of passage and reflect on their own beliefs and values.

Science

This half term we will be learning about the circulatory system. We will use our maths skills to collect, present and interpret data on the effect of exercise on our heart rate and pulse.
