## Weekly Attendance Rewards

Each week, we celebrate the classes with the best attendance by awarding our attendance trophies. These are proudly displayed on the Greenmount Mountain in the reception area and announced by the Headteacher during assembly.

## 100% Club

Children who achieve 100% attendance for the week are recognised in their class as part of our 100% Club, with their achievement displayed weekly.

## Reception Attendance Stickers

Every Friday, pupils in Reception who achieve 100% attendance receive a special sticker as a reward for their excellent attendance.

## “Give it 100%” Incentives

Throughout the year, we run “Give it 100%” attendance initiatives to encourage and boost attendance across the school.

## Termly Prize Draw

Every term, children who achieve 96% attendance or above are entered into a special prize draw as a reward for their commitment to attending school regularly.
