Term: Autumn 1. Topic: Where in the world is Beeston?

Literacy

We will be reading the stories 'Through the Fairy door' and 'Sam and Dave Dig a hole'. We will write simple sentences focusing on finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Home Learning: You can help by reading lots of stories at bedtime and encourage children to predict what will happen next.

Maths

Count, write and make numbers to 10 and beyond.
Finding one more and one less than a number.
Simple addition and subtraction.

Home Learning: You can help by doing lots of counting- counting toys, objects, looking for numbers when shopping. See if your child can write all the numbers to ten the correct way round.

Geography: Learning all about Beeston and the human and physical features of our local area.
