Settling in

Thank you to parents for bringing your child every day to Nursery. We realise it can be upsetting to see your child cry when you leave but let us reassure you that they do stop and can be seen playing in the setting soon after. We will always try to ring you to let you know they are ok.

Baseline Assessments

During these first few weeks of Nursery, staff have been enjoying getting to know all the children. We have been watching them play and interacting with them as much as possible. This is giving us a good picture of where the children are at developmentally at this time of year and what their interests are.

Our topic—'Where in the World is Beeston?'

We will look at who lives with the children. Who is in your family. Where we live. Do the children know they live in Beeston? What is in our local area?

Phonics

In Early Years and KS1 we are using a new phonics scheme called 'Floppy's Phonics'. In Nursery, the focus is on hearing environmental sounds, body percussion and lots of rhymes. You can help at home by singing Nursery rhymes and listening for sounds as you are out and about
