Topic: Let's Celebrate...

Literacy

This term we will be looking at traditional tales and writing our own alternative endings. We will be using adjectives, nouns, verbs and conjunctions in our writing and learning how to use commas in a list. We will continue sharing lots of stories, practising our reading and ensuring we write in full sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Maths

We will counting, 2s, 5s and 10s. Addition and subtraction including recalling number bonds and fact families.

Vocabulary

Add, plus, more than, greater than, take-away, subtract, less than, fewer than, equal to, the same as, multiples of, the difference

Topic (Art, DT, History, Geography)

We will be learning about:

- Our wonderful world including the name of the continents and oceans. We will learn about the different traditions and celebrations around the world.
- In DT we will taste various dips and design our own; practicing our chopping, grating, mixing, snipping and peeling skills.
